Below, you'll find 52 key promises, grouped into nine major themes, each accompanied by the complete verse from the New International Version (NIV).

AGREEING WITH HIS PROMISES

1. Find it.

Discover the promise from God's word.

2. Keep it close.

Write it out, print it out.

3. Speak it.

Declare it, pray the promise, meditate on it

4. Live it.

Begin to make adjustments in your life like the promise is already fulfilled.

5. Hold it.

Persevere, endure, be patient, resilience.

6. Praise God.

Give Him the glory, honour and praise for being true to His word.

Salvation & Forgiveness

Salvation lies at the very centre of God's plan. Throughout the Bible, we see His longing to redeem humanity, offering forgiveness, adoption into His family, and the gift of eternal life to everyone who puts their faith in Jesus Christ.

1. Promise of Salvation – Romans 10:9

“If you declare with your mouth, ‘Jesus is Lord,’ and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.”

2. Eternal Life – John 3:16

“For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.”

3. Forgiveness of Sins – 1 John 1:9

“If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.”

4. No Condemnation – Romans 8:1

“Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.”

5. God's Unfailing Love – Jeremiah 31:3

“The LORD appeared to us in the past, saying: ‘I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have drawn you with unfailing kindness.’”

6. Adoption as God's Children – John 1:12

“Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God.”

7. The Gift of the Holy Spirit – Acts 2:38

“Peter replied, ‘Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.’”

8. Redemption from Sin – Ephesians 1:7

“In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace.”

God's Presence & Help

God promises to be close to us, never abandoning or forsaking His people.
His presence brings courage, support, and strength in every situation.

9. God Never Leaves Us – Hebrews 13:5

“Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, ‘Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.’”

10. God is Always with Us – Joshua 1:9

“Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go.”

11. Answer to Prayer – Jeremiah 33:3

“Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.”

12. God's Guidance – Proverbs 3:5-6

“Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.”

13. God's Strength in Weakness – 2 Corinthians 12:9

“But he said to me, ‘My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.’ Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me.”

14. Help in Temptation – 1 Corinthians 10:13

“No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.”

15. God Cares for Our Needs – 1 Peter 5:7

“Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.”

Provision

God provides for every need—whether physical, spiritual, or emotional. Scripture assures us that our Father will supply all that is truly necessary for our well-being.

16. God Will Provide Needs – Philippians 4:19

“And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.”

17. Daily Needs Supplied – Matthew 6:31-33

“So do not worry, saying, ‘What shall we eat?’ or ‘What shall we drink?’ or ‘What shall we wear?’ For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.”

18. God Gives Wisdom Generously – James 1:5

“If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.”

19. The Lord is My Shepherd – Psalm 23:1

“The LORD is my shepherd, I lack nothing.”

20. Blessings for Financial Obedience – Malachi 3:10

“Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,” says the LORD Almighty, “and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it.”

21. God Opens Doors that No One Can Shut – Revelation 3:8

“I know your deeds. See, I have placed before you an open door that no one can shut.”

Protection & Safety

God promises protection and refuge. Even in the midst of danger, temptation, or persecution, He faithfully watches over His people.

22. Protection from Harm – Psalm 91:10-11

“No harm will overtake you, no disaster will come near your tent. For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways.”

23. No Weapon Formed Shall Prosper – Isaiah 54:17

“No weapon forged against you will prevail, and you will refute every tongue that accuses you. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and this is their vindication from me,” declares the LORD.

24. God is Our Refuge – Psalm 46:1

“God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.”

25. Deliverance from Fear – Psalm 34:4

“I sought the LORD, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears.”

26. Peace in Trouble – John 16:33

“I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world.”

27. Preservation Through Trials – Isaiah 43:2

“When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned; the flames will not set you ablaze.”

Peace, Comfort & Rest

God invites us to find rest in Him, offering peace, joy, and comfort—even in times of sorrow, pain, or loss.

28. Peace Beyond Understanding – Philippians 4:6-7

“Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”

29. Comfort in Sorrow – 2 Corinthians 1:3-4

“Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God.”

30. Rest for the Weary – Matthew 11:28-30

“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.”

31. God Heals Brokenhearted – Psalm 147:3

“He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.”

32. Joy in God’s Presence – Psalm 16:11

“You make known to me the path of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand.”

Strength & Courage

God strengthens and empowers us to face life's challenges with courage, assuring us that His help is always available.

33. Renewed Strength – Isaiah 40:31

“But those who hope in the LORD will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.”

34. Courage in Difficulty – Deuteronomy 31:6

“Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the LORD your God goes with you; he will never leave you nor forsake you.”

35. Victory Over Fear – 2 Timothy 1:7

“For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.”

36. Power to Overcome – 1 John 4:4

“You, dear children, are from God and have overcome them, because the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.”

37. God Upholds You – Isaiah 41:10

“So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.”

Guidance & Wisdom

38. Guidance for Life's Path – Psalm 32:8

"I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my loving eye on you."

39. He Directs Our Steps – Proverbs 16:9

"In their hearts humans plan their course, but the LORD establishes their steps."

40. Wisdom to All Who Ask – James 1:5

"If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you."

41. Understanding God's Will – Ephesians 5:17

"Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is."

Growth & Transformation

42. Renewed Mind – Romans 12:2

“But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be glory both now and forever! Amen.”

44. Fruit of the Spirit – Galatians 5:22-23

“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.”

45. God Completes His Work in You – Philippians 1:6

“Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.”

Hope & Future

God gives hope that extends beyond today, offering the promise of eternal life, Christ's return, and a glorious inheritance for all who believe.

46. Hope and a Future – Jeremiah 29:11

“For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the LORD, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.”

47. All Things Work for Good – Romans 8:28

“And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.”

48. Inheritance in Heaven – 1 Peter 1:3-4

“Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade. This inheritance is kept in heaven for you.”

49. God Wipes Away Every Tear – Revelation 21:4

“He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.”

50. Christ's Return – John 14:2-3

“My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am.”

51. Resurrection of the Dead – 1 Corinthians 15:52-53

“In a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. For the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality.”

52. Eternal Security – John 10:28-29

“I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one will snatch them out of my hand. My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand.”
